Eco Stor's large-scale battery energy storage system (BESS) in Bollingstedt, Schleswig-Holsteinconsisting of 64 lithium-ion battery modules and 32 inverter containers—was inaugurated on June 6, 2025, after going live in April. Featuring a 103.5 MW capacity and 238 MWh storage volume, it ranks among Germany's largest BESS deployments.

RWE has officially brought online the Beg Ar C'Hra wind farm in Brittany, located across the communes of Plounévez-Moëdec and Plounérin. The facility comprises four Nordex N117 turbines with a combined capacity of 14.7 MW. Developed in partnership with the semi-public Lannion-Trégor company, the project secured its environmental permit in 2022 and entered construction in late
